BAWBURGH GOLF CLUB - MEN'S SECTION RULES FOR THE 2022 PAUL GREENGRASS ORDER OF MERIT CUP

The Paul Greengrass Men's Order of Merit will be open to all male members of Bawburgh Golf Club who have an official WHS Handicap Index when entering any of the qualifying competitions listed herein. No further entry fee will be required for the Order of Merit Cup.

Each qualifying competition is ranked, according to its profile, within the following three Tier System. The higher ranked the tier, the more prestigious the qualifying competition and the more points that are available. There is **no limit** to the number of qualifying competitions in which a player may enter and score points, however only your best 15 qualifying scores may count towards your final total.

If any qualifying competition is not held on a specified or rearranged date, or if any knockout competition is not completed, the other competitions will remain qualifying for the Order of Merit Cup, subject to minimum of 10 being completed. If less than 10 are completed, the Order of Merit Cup for that calendar year will be cancelled.

Points accumulated will be calculated and recorded by the Golf Office, and a table of the leading aggregate scores will be published after each event.

Tier 1 (6 Competitions)

Bawburgh Masters (4th/5th June 2022), Club Handicap Championship (10th/11th September 2022) and Charity Stableford (1st/2nd October 2022) - all based on the overall 2-day results - plus the Stewards Cup, Summer Knockout and Alex Birrell Pairs (all to be completed by TBC October 2022).

Tier 2 (18 Competitions)

Six Monthly (Sunday) Medals from April to September (17th April, 29th May, 27th June, 26th July, 31st August 28th and 18th September 2022), as defined by the Men's Section Committee, plus the Spring Stableford (1st May 2022), Entertainments Trophy (21st May 2022), Captain's Cup (16th July 2021) and Spooner Trophy (20th August 2022). Four Midweek (Wednesday) Medals (11th May, 8th June, 13th July and 10th August 2022) and four Midweek (Wednesday) Stablefords (25th May, 22nd June, 27th July and 24th August 2022) from May to August, as defined by the Men's Section Committee.

Tier 3 (6 Competitions)

Six Saturday Stableford Competitions (yellow tees) including the Rover Cup (2nd April) & 5 Optional stableford competitions from May – September (14th May , 18th June, 23rd July, 13th August, 24th September)

The Paul Greengrass Order of Merit Cup will be awarded to the player with the most points accumulated from the qualifying competitions listed herein, and have his name added to the relevant honour board. In addition, prize vouchers will be awarded as follows:

1st place	£200.00
2nd place	£100.00
3 rd place	£80.00
4th place	£60.00
5 th place	£40.00
6th place	£20.00

Apart from the winner, all prizes in respect of tied scores will be shared. In the event of a tie for the winner, it will be the player with the highest total of points accumulated during Tier 1 qualifying competitions. If still tied, it will be the player with the best points from the club championship, and if still tied players on the same total of points will share the trophy and prize voucher.

There will also be a prize voucher for the 1st place finisher in the Scratch OOM. This will be to the value of £50.00. The points allocation and qualifying competitions will mirror the nett version, but purely in a gross format.

Winning in Final 400

Points awarded in Alex Birrell Pairs will be shared 50/50 between partners. If one or more of the Knockout competitions are not completed, the points allocated for the rounds played will still be included in the overall totals if 10 other qualifying competitions are completed.
