

BAWBURGH GOLF CLUB - MEN'S SECTION RULES FOR THE MIKE SOWERBY GROSS & NETT ECLECTIC TROPHY

The Mike Sowerby Gross & Nett Eclectic Trophy will be open to all male members of Bawburgh Golf Club who have an official WHS Handicap Index when entering any of the 28 individual qualifying competitions listed below.

Only the scores from these qualifying competitions, all of which shall be played from white tees and on dates within that calendar year as specified by the Men's Section Committee, will be recorded:

- Bawburgh Masters (days 1 & 2 separately);
 - Handicap Club Championship (days 1 & 2 separately);
 - Dudley Woods (Scratch & Net)
 - Spring Stableford;
 - Entertainments Trophy;
 - Captain's Cup;
 - Spooner Trophy;
 - 6 Monthly (Sunday) Medals from April to September, as defined by the Men's Section Committee; and
 - 6 Midweek (Wednesday) Medals and 6 Midweek (Wednesday) Stablefords from April to September, as defined by the Men's Section Committee.
1. If any qualifying competition is not held on a specified or rearranged date, or is not played from the white tees, the other competitions will remain as qualifying for the Eclectic Trophy, subject to minimum of 10 competitions being completed. If less than 10 competitions are completed, the Eclectic Trophy for that calendar year will be cancelled.
 2. The lowest gross scores, and lowest nett scores based upon Playing Handicaps on the day of each qualifying competition, on each hole will be recorded by the Golf Office for every player taking part, and a table of the leading aggregate scores will be published after each event.
 3. There will be no additional fee due in respect of the Eclectic Trophy.
 4. The player(s) with each of the lowest aggregate gross and lowest aggregate nett scores, after all completed qualifying competitions, will be declared the winner(s).
 5. In the event of a tie, the winner(s) and placings will be determined by their lowest score on count-back, being the last 9 holes, last 6, last 3, and last hole and, if still tied, the last 6, last 3 and last hole on the front nine. If still tied, players on the same score will share the trophy and prize voucher.

6. The Mike Sowerby Trophy will be presented jointly to the winner(s) of the Gross and Nett events. . In addition prize vouchers will be awarded to gross and nett as follows

1st prize £25

2nd prize 315

3rd prize £10
